**W**aterfront houses sell for a premium. Apartments that face the pool command a higher price than those that do not. Condominiums that enjoy sea view can worth millions here. Why are people willing to exhaust their coffers so that they are able to have *Water* in front of their residences? In this issue of ProsperTimes™, I shall offer you a Feng Shui perspective of the miraculous power of water on your house or apartment.

Feng Shui (风水) literally means *Wind* and *Water*. A pool of water holds the energies or *Qi*, while flowing water carries *Qi* along. Presence of water catchment areas and the study of water flows are extremely important in analysing the Feng Shui configuration of a certain place. Having water in the correct place will bring good luck and prosperity. On the contrary, placing the fish pond or fish tank in the wrong sector will lead to bad luck and calamities.

# Types of Water

**T**here are different types of water. Water could be natural, man-made or virtual. It could also be mercilessly catastrophic, gentle flowing, stagnant, clean or polluted.

Sea, rivers and lakes are considered natural water, while reservoirs, swimming pools and monsoon canals are categorised as man-made water. Nowadays, in our urban landscape, it may difficult to find real water, thus the directional meandering of roads are deemed to be virtual water that also brings along masses of energies with it.

Generally, we would like water to be clean, gentle flowing and without unpleasant odour.

## Rule of Thumb

The general rule of thumb is to have water in front and not at the back of your house. In addition, the land in front has to be low lying.

This applies to all types of water, including virtual water too. That means you should have roads in front of your house and not at the back.

A flyover in front of your house is deemed as unfavourable if it is higher than your residence. This is because it signifies water overhead and it has a "drowning" effect on the occupants, thus causing undue stress and anxiety.







# Using *Water* to Activate Your Auspicious Sectors

## Activators of Auspicious Sectors

Water is life. Water can also act as crucial activators in auspicious sectors of your homes or offices. Strategic locations of your pond, fish tank or water feature will enhance and improve wealth and prosperity of the occupants significantly!

## Where should I place my pond, fish tank or water feature?

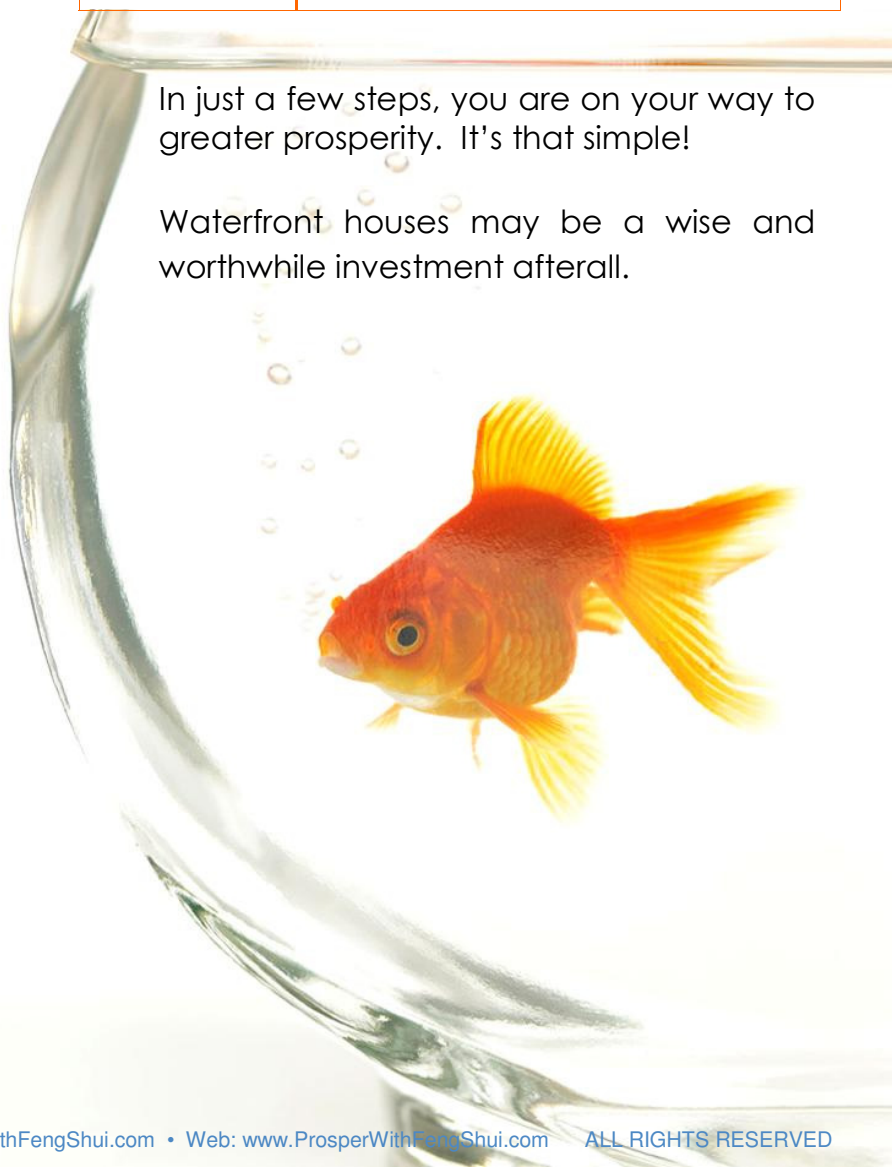
Although effects may vary among different individuals, I shall share with you a general method in identifying the auspicious sector of your home or office. After which, you may place your fish tank or water feature in that specific sector and you will be amazed and start to reap the benefits very soon!

In order to locate your auspicious sector, you must first identify the facing direction of your house or office. Next, check the given table for your auspicious sector. Lastly, use a compass to identify that sector and place a fish tank or water feature there to start activating the auspicious energies.

Facing Direction	Where You Should Place Your Fish Tank/Water Feature
West	South
Northwest	North
North	East
South	Southeast
Southeast	West
East	Northwest
Southwest	Southwest
Northeast	Northeast

In just a few steps, you are on your way to greater prosperity. It's that simple!

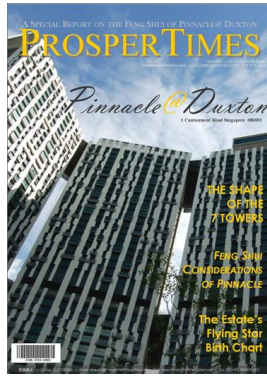
